WHEREAS, Illinois residents are aware of the contributions made by the recreational water industry, as represented by the organizations involved in the National Water Safety Month Coalition, in the rapid development of safe swimming facilities, aquatic programs, home pools and spas, and related activities which provide healthy places to recreate, learn and grow, build self-esteem, confidence, and sense of self-worth; and,

WHEREAS, residents of Illinois recognize the ongoing effort and commitment to educate the public on pool and spa safety by the pool, spa, waterpark, recreation, and parks industries; and,

WHEREAS, Illinoisans understand the vital importance of communicating water safety rules and programs to families and individuals of all ages, whether owners of private pools, users of public swimming facilities, or visitors to waterparks;

THEREFORE, I, JB Pritzker, Governor of the State of Illinois, do hereby declare May 2024 as National Water Safety Month and urge all Illinois residents to support and promote this observance.
