PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, citizens of Indiana recognize the vital role that swimming and aquatic-related activities relate to good physical and mental health and enhance the quality of life for all people; and
- WHEREAS, the citizens of Indiana understand the essential role that education regarding the topic of Water Safety plays in preventing drownings and recreational water-related injuries; and
- WHEREAS, the Indiana are aware of the contributions made by the recreational water industry, as represented by the organizations involved in the National Water Safety Month Coalition in developing safe swimming facilities, aquatic programs, home pools and spas, and related activities providing healthy places to recreate, learn and grow, build self-esteem, confidence and sense of self-worth which contributes to the quality of life in our community; and
- WHEREAS, the citizens of Indiana recognize the ongoing efforts and commitments to educate the public on pool and spa safety issues and initiatives by the pool, spa, waterpark, recreation and parks industries; and
- WHEREAS, the citizens of Indiana understand the vital importance of communicating Water Safety rules and programs to families and individuals of all ages.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike Braun, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim May 1- May 31, 2026, as

INDIANA WATER SAFETY MONTH
in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
