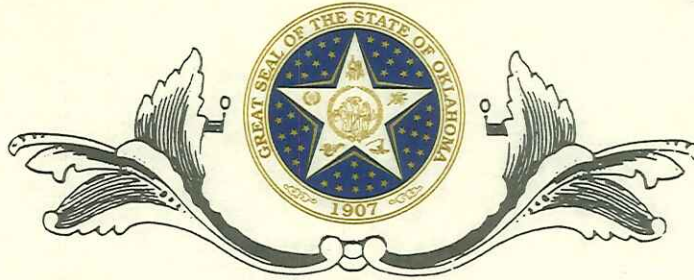

**Whereas**, the citizens of Oklahoma recognize the ongoing efforts and commitments to educate the public on pool and spa safety; and

**Whereas**, the citizens of Oklahoma understand the vital importance of communicating water safety rules and programs to families and individuals of all ages, whether owners of private pools, users of public swimming facilities, or visitors to waterparks;

**Now Therefore**, I, Governor J. Kevin Stitt, do hereby proclaim May 2025, as

**"Oklahoma Water Safety Month"**
