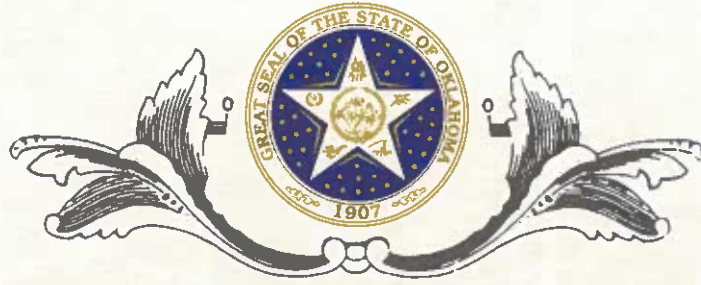

Proclamation

Whereas, education and awareness regarding water safety are essential to preventing drownings and reducing recreational water-related injuries; and

Whereas, organizations within the recreational water industry and the National Water Safety Month Coalition work to promote safe swimming environments, aquatic programs, and responsible use of pools, spas, and water recreation facilities; and

Whereas, the pool, spa, waterpark, recreation, and parks industries continue to support public education and safety initiatives that help protect Oklahoma families and communities; and

Whereas, promoting water safety rules and programs for individuals of all ages, whether at home pools, public swimming facilities, or waterparks, ensure safer aquatic experiences for all Oklahomans; and

Now Therefore, I, Governor J. Kevin Stitt, do hereby proclaim May 2026,
as

“Water Safety Month”
