PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, it is the mission of the coalition to develop safe swimming facilities, aquatic programs, and safe opportunities for recreation, fitness, and relaxation; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvanians recognize that swimming and aqua-related activities relate to good physical and mental health and enhance the quality of life for all; and

WHEREAS, it is important to identify the essential role of water safety education in preventing drowning and recreational water-related injuries; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvanians understand the vital importance of communicating water safety rules and programs to families and individuals of all ages, whether owners of private pools, users of public swimming facilities, or visitors to waterparks.
