PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Tennessee is blessed with one of the most remarkable and abundant waterway systems in the country; and

WHEREAS, with more than 580,000 acres of lakes and reservoirs, over 61,000 miles of rivers and streams, and countless lakes and ponds, more than 59% of all Tennesseans participate in water-related sports and activities; and

WHEREAS, Tennesseans are aware of the importance of communicating water safety rules and programs to children, adults, and caregivers of all ages; and

WHEREAS, Water Safety Month in Tennessee is an opportunity to increase public awareness of measures that can prevent water-related deaths and injuries such as knowing the basics of swimming, complete boating safety class and learning cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR);

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim May 2025 as

Water Safety Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
