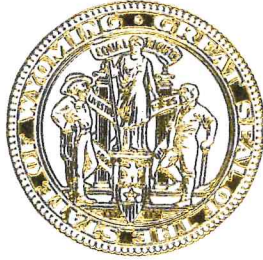


Governor's Proclamation

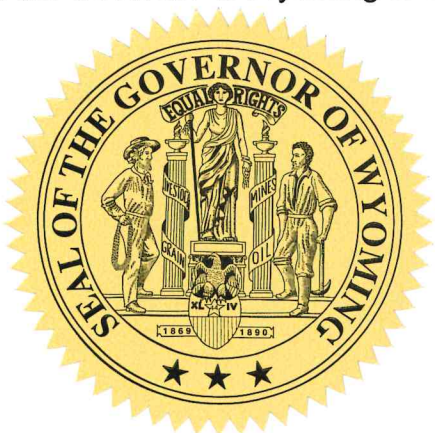
