Proclamation

WHEREAS: As the land of 10,000 lakes, Minnesota recognizes how swimming, boating, and water

sports contribute to the health, well-being, and culture of our state; and

WHEREAS: It is critical that all people in Minnesota are educated in water safety to prevent

drownings and injuries and ensure our lakes, rivers, ponds, and pools can be enjoyed; and

WHEREAS: Everyone has a responsibility to practice water safety and spread awareness of safety

practices – especially those who own or operate pools, spas, and watersport equipment

that is used by friends, family, neighbors, and visitors in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: There are many individuals and organizations committed to educating the public on

water safety issues, with many initiatives led by the pool, spa, waterpark, recreation, and

parks industries; and

WHEREAS: The National Water Safety Month Coalition helps to develop safe swimming facilities,

aquatic programs, home pools and spas, and related activities, providing healthy places to play, learn, grow, and build confidence, contributing to the quality of life and the

spread of joy in our communities; and

WHEREAS: All people in Minnesota are encouraged to support, promote, and practice water safety in

their daily lives.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 2025 as:

WATER SAFETY MONTH

in the State of Minnesota.
